



Yerevan, Armenia March 20, 2008

Dear Mr. Minister:

At the request of Richard Douglas, Deputy Assistant Secretary of Defense for Counternarcotics, Counterproliferation and Global Threats from the Office of the Secretary of Defense, it is my pleasure to deliver to you a letter thanking the Government of Armenia for its interest, as expressed in Health Minister Kushkian's October 23, 2007 letter, in participating in the Biological Threat Reduction Program (BTRP) run by the Department of Defense.

As you will read in the Deputy Assistant Secretary's letter, the first step in initiating Armenia's participation in the BTRP is to conclude an implementing agreement.

You will see that the Department of Defense initially planned to send a delegation to Armenia in early March to discuss the BTRP, but this was postponed in light of recent events. We have no indication yet when the trip will be rescheduled, but will notify the Foreign Ministry as soon as information becomes available to us.
