As Full-Time Lecturer in International Marketing Research and Chairperson for the Specialisation International Marketing and Foreign Trade at the department of Export-Oriented Management of the IMC University of Applied Sciences Krems (Austria) I am very pleased to recommend Ms. Eva PROKOPIEVA by means of this letter.
