5. Description of Problem, Suggested Intervention and List of Items

Brief description of the current situation which is to be targeted by the earmarked donation, and list of required items covered by the donation.

Strengthening of the preparedness planning for effective response to infectious diseases outbreak is one of the major priorities of the country. Currently, transportation of the patients infected with especially dangerous pathogens to the appropriate health facilities are conducted by the emergency medical team with ordinary ambulance and in such cases protection of the medical team and vehicle itself from the infections is of high importance. Considering current epidemiological situation, isolated and safe transportation of the infected patients became more important. Also, it should be noted that the majority of hospitals are lack of specially designated routs to safely transfer patients from the reception to the isolated wards. Therefore, the necessity of bioboxes are of critical importance in Georgia. This project could provide an excellent opportunity to prevents and minimize the risk of spreading dangerous infections to medical staff and health facilities.
