


ADAMO HOTEL

Heritage of History, Architecture and Arts

Built in 80th by famous Georgian architect. Master of Guild of Art - Vakhtang Davitaia, the historical building of Hotel Adamo was a Ritual Palace with beautiful city views and gardens.

It was performed in Italian style with tall columns and hanging chandeliers.

In early 90th, the building was owned by famous Georgian sculptor – Elguja Amashukeli.

Soon after Elguja Amashukeli had to leave Georgia by personal reasons, in 1992 the ownership of the building was granted to Fund of Culture of Georgia as Exhibition Hall by decision of Georgian government.

There were held different types of art exhibitions here, performed with academy students and known Georgian masters artworks.

In 2007, after reconstruction and renovation work done by Vakhtang Davitaia, the building was renamed to Center of Arts "Mtatsminda".

Today, the building of Hotel Adamo is architectural pearl of the city, with historical and art heritage of Georgia.

Hotel's exterior and interior was performed by team of famous Georgian architects, sculptors, artists and designers. To reflect all of the aspects of Georgian hospitality the hotel art-team retained native Georgian elements in addition to pleasant coziness and comfort created by modern stylish details.

Beautiful and masterly crafted arts of well-known Georgian sculptors, artists and designers are gathered inside the hotel walls. There are works of Geno Zaqaraia, Rusudan Petviashvili, Mikheil Tsotsoria, Qeti Matabeli. and Nodar Shatirishvili.

Hotel's room planning and design was performed by Vakhtang Davitaia's apprentice – architect Andro Petviashvili, who's hard work made possible the excellence, quality and comfort that every Hotel Adamo's guest can touch right from the very entrance.
