#### Registration

The meeting will be conducted in English. Captioning and interpretation services will also be provided.

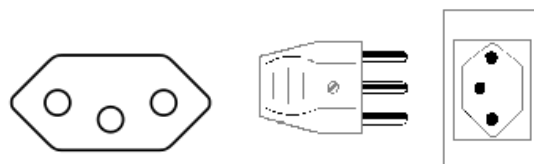
#### Documentation

The meeting will be paperless. All meeting information will be available on the WHO Event APP. Participants will be emailed closer to the meeting

date, with information on how to download the app and find the relevant information.

## Swiss plug-sockets

Swiss plug-sockets supply the European standard voltage of 230 V AC - 50 Hz. Plug-sockets are shaped as seen in the picture below. Most plugs with two prongs can also be used.

## Headquarters Facilities

The following facilities are available at WHO.

**Post Office:** Situated on level S1 next to the Café Ritazza (see below). It is open from 08:30 to 16:30, and provides full postal, telegraph and telephone facilities.

**Bank:** The Union des Banques Suisses (UBS) handles routine banking and exchange operations. It is located on the ground floor of the L building. ATM facilities are also available next to the Café Ritazza (see below).

**Travel Agent:** Carlson Wagonlit Travel Agency (tel. 14071). It is open from 09:00 to 16:30 Monday – Friday.

**Cafeteria / Restaurant:** Located close to the executive board room on level S1. The restaurant provides 4 to 5 different "plats du jour" options each day, including a vegetarian option and a salad bar. It is open from 11:30 to 14:00 Monday - Friday.

**Café Ritazza:** Situated in the main hall on level S1, open from 07:30 to 16:00 Monday - to Friday. It provides coffees, tea, sandwiches, snacks etc.

**Library:** Situated in the main hall on level S1, open from 08:30 to 17:00 from Monday - Friday (tel. 12062). Several computers with internet access and printer are available.

**Cyber Café:** Free access to internet is available on the mezzanine level.

**Medical Services:** open from 08:15 to 12:45 and from 13:30 to 17:00 from Monday – Friday. Located on level S2 near the Executive Board room.

## To/From Airport

Geneva city centre is very close to the airport. It is easily reachable by train or by bus using the united network of public transport Unireso. Only one single ticket is required to travel by train, tram, or bus in Geneva.

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### Geneva Transport Card

UNIRESO offers a Transport Card to guests of Geneva hotels which is valid for all forms of transport within Geneva. You can get this card at your hotel reception.

**There is a ticket machine in the baggage claim area at the airport where you are able to get a free one-way ticket that can be used on the bus, train or tram.**

**By Train:** Train is the easiest way to reach Geneva city centre: 8 minutes between the Airport and Cornavin central station (every 15 minutes). All trains stop at Geneva-Cornavin. The Airport railway station has direct access to the Airport Departure/Arrival levels.

**By Bus:** The following buses stop at the airport (bus stops at the Departure level, in front of the train station): <http://www.tpg.ch/>

- to Geneva city centre: bus 5 (every 10 minutes); get off the bus at Gare Cornavin or Coutance.
- to Geneva city centre: bus 10 (every 10 minutes); get off the bus at Coutance. It takes 25 minutes.
- to WHO: bus 28 (every 20 minutes). It takes 15 minutes. Get off at the bus stop called "OMS". As you step off the bus WHO is the large building to your left.

**How much does it cost?** It costs 3.00 Chf (Swiss franc) for any single trip of one hour or less within Geneva city. You must buy your ticket **before** getting onto the bus. Ticket machines are available at all stops - please select the button for 1-hour trip. It is the only one with a red circle around the button.

In most cases, the machine does not provide change so please try and carry the correct coins.

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### To/From WHO

WHO headquarters building is situated at the end of Avenue Appia on the outskirts of Geneva, about 3 kilometres from the centre of town and about 1.5 kilometres from the Palais des Nations (United Nations).

**By Bus:** The bus number 8, direction OMS (OMS means WHO in French) goes to WHO from the station Cornavin. WHO is the last stop.

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### Taxi

Most Geneva taxi drivers know the headquarters building as "OMS" (Avenue Appia). There are taxi stands located at almost all main squares in Geneva. Taxis can be called by telephone by dialling the following numbers: (022) 320 20 20, (022) 320 22 02 and (022) 33 141 33. The WHO Reception will also order taxis.

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## Access Information

### Accessibility of trains, trams, bus routes:

#### Bus:

Modern vehicles have a ramp for access, and a button for requesting assistance from the driver. Older vehicles are inaccessible, and so it may not be possible to use the first bus which arrives at the stop. Because buses generally run frequently, wheelchair users can generally expect an accessible bus to arrive within a reasonable period. Tram lines 13, 14, 16 are also wheelchair accessible. Most buses and trams have display screens and announcements of each stop.
