Given the diverse state health priorities and fiscal capacity it was therefore imperative to develop an Essential Health Package (EHP) that was both flexible to states needs and pragmatic in considering existing mechanisms in delivery. The NEHP outlined in the High Level Expert Group (HLEG) Report on UHC ensures affordable, accountable and appropriate quality health services (Primary, Secondary and Tertiary) to all citizens
