AMR AND HAI: A MAJOR EUROPEAN AND GLOBAL HEALTH CHALLENGE

Excessive and inappropriate use of antimicrobial medicines and poor infection control practices have boosted AMR to become a serious threat to public health worldwide. Every year in the EU alone, an estimated 25 000 patients die because of infections, that cannot be treated with antimicrobial drugs. Infections due to these selected multidrug-resistant bacteria in the EU result in extra health care costs and productivity losses of at least €1.5 billion each year.

This session offers a comprehensive presentation under the One Health perspective on what key stakeholders are doing in the Central European Region to tackle this problem.
