The Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the Republic of Estonia is hereby to convey that the Government of Estonia has looked into opportunities to respond to the requests of the Government of Georgia, related to the response of the coronavirus outbreak and has decided to send the consignment of humanitarian aid as described below:

- 1. Hand disinfectant (500ml bottle with dispenser), amount 3000 units (1500L) to the Ministry of Internally Displaced Persons from the Occupied Territories, Labour, Health and Social Affairs of Georgia
- 2. Hand disinfectant (1L bottle), amount 600L and surface disinfectant (5L canister), amount 400L to the United Water Supply Company of Georgia (Ministry of Infrastructure and Regional Development of Georgia)

From the technical side, I would plead for your cooperation to inform the relevant authorities on your side, in order to allow the items to pass without any delay or hindrances.

While praising the excellent manner in which the Government of Georgia has been managing the coronavirus outbreak, I hope that our small friendly contribution will make a small but important difference in your endeavors.
