## COVID-19 and Needs of Migrants in South Caucasus

### ANNOUNCEMENT

Based on the findings of the Rapid Needs Assessment of COVID19 vulnerabilities among 3<sup>rd</sup> country migrants in Georgia, the International Organization for Migration (IOM) intends to provide urgent assistance and support vulnerable migrants to address basic food and hygiene, housing/accommodation, personal documents and/or medical needs.

#### WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE SUPPORT:

- Migrants in irregular situations (i.e. those who have overstayed visas, whose personal documents have expired, etc.)
- Low skilled/low income labor migrants without income
- Foreign students
- Rejected asylum seekers

who are in a dire economic situation, in urgent need of food and/or shelter and/or are experiencing urgent medical issues they have no financial means to address.

#### WHO IS NOT ELIGIBLE FOR THE SUPPORT:

- Persons with Georgian citizenship
- Persons with the permanent residence permit in Georgia

To apply for the assistance, applicants falling under any of above-mentioned migrant groups and fulfilling vulnerability criteria should register for in person interview by 30 September 2020 via:
