... The Director-General of the World Health Organization presents his compliments to Member States and Associate Members and has the honour to attach a draft provisional agenda for the 148th session of the Executive Board to be held from 18 to 26 January 2021.<sup>1</sup>

In accordance with Rule 8 of the Rules of Procedure of the Executive Board, any proposal from a Member State or Associate Member to include an item on the agenda would normally reach the Director-General not later than 10 weeks before the commencement of the session of the Executive Board, that is by 9 November 2020. A balance will be sought between the duration of the session and the number of items proposed on the agenda. Thereafter, the Director-General will draw up the provisional agenda in consultation with Officers of the Executive Board. The provisional agenda will be annotated and explain any deferral or exclusion of proposals made. It will be dispatched to Member States with the letter of convocation eight weeks before commencement of the session.

The Director-General of the World Health Organization takes this opportunity to renew to Member States and Associate Members the assurance of his highest consideration.
