## STATEMENT

As is well known, loop diuretics are an important component of first line treatment in the treatment of heart failure. Over time, the patient becomes resistant to diuretics, and heart failure cannot be compensated by medical treatment. It is also important to manage rhythm disturbances in patients with moderate to high functional grade heart failure. Hospitalization due to heart failure is increased in patients with rhythm disturbances, which causes increased healthcare costs for the healthcare system as well as patients themselves. Due to this, it is extremely important to study heart failure physiology and the electrophysiology of rhythm disturbances, as well as the introduction of treatment methods for the development of cardiology and medicine in general.

Our clinic has decided to share our experience, as well as receive information about new opportunities and treatment options in heart failure from an American colleague, who will share his experience in electrophysiology. Training on the latest heart failure management methodologies will be held in "Israeli-Georgian Medical Research Clinic Helsicore" which will be attended by the clinical team of our clinic. This will increase the readiness and qualification of our team for the latest approaches in heart failure management.
