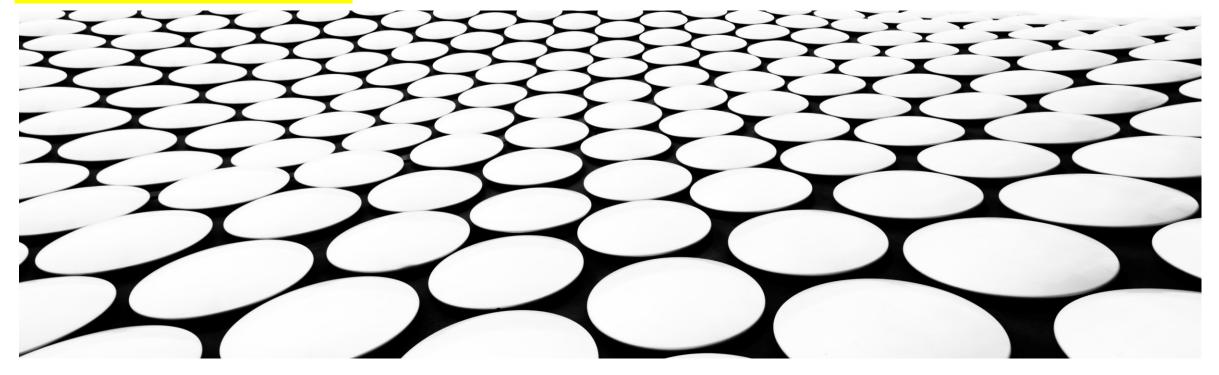

1. HOW MANY HOURS IS YOUR EMPLOYEE ON DUTY?

This is an example calculation on annual available working time for on full time equivalent (FTE)

Workdays per Week	5
* Working weeks per annum	52
= Workdays per year	260
- Holidays that fall on a working day (on average)	10
- Holiday leave	24
- Sick leave (on average)	5
- Training Days and other absence times (on average)	15
= annual available work days	206
* Working hours per day	8

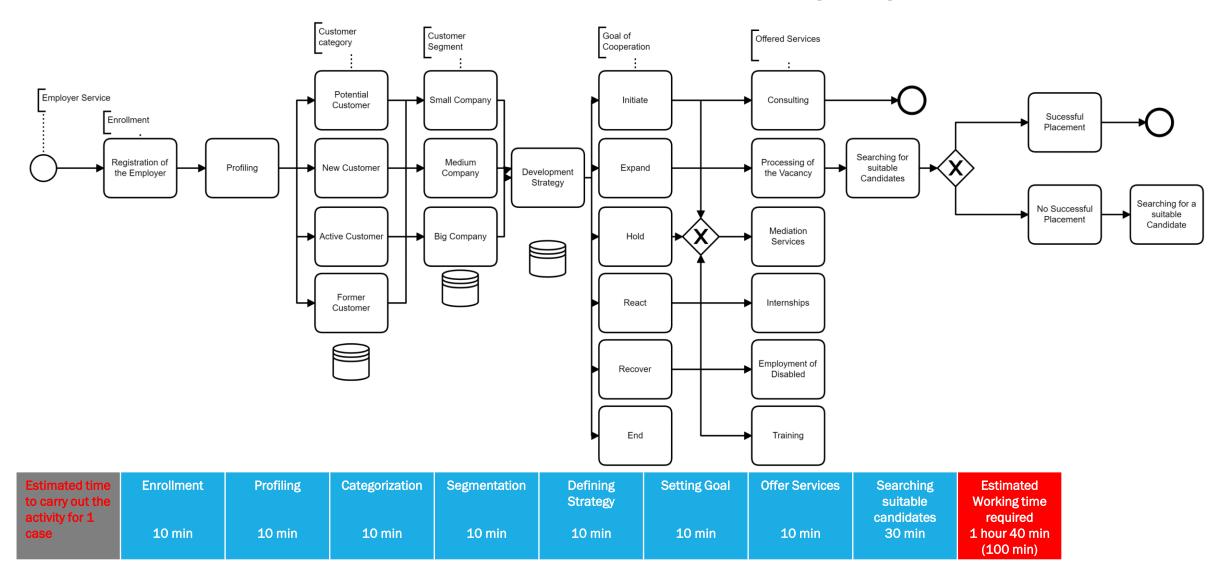
One Staff Member is in this example calculation on duty for 1.236 hours/yearly.

2. CACULATING STAFF RESOURCES BASED ON WORK ANALYSES

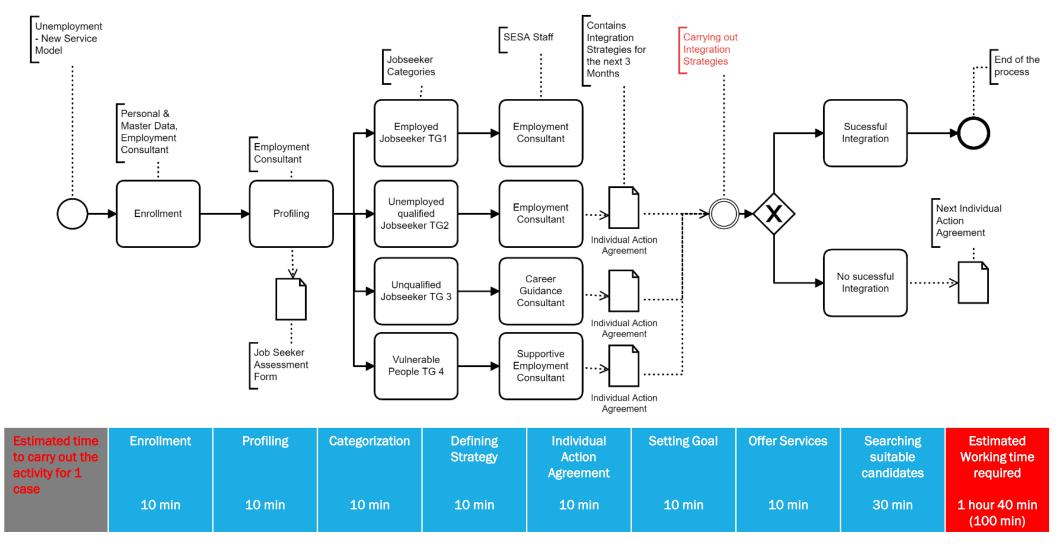
Notice:

The human resources needed to implement strategic programmes are usually based on detailed work analyses. As we do not have such work analyses, we can only work with estimates. This presentation works with the estimated time required to deliver an end-2-end service under the new service model. It is assumed that the end-2end process for jobseekers and employers will take 100 minutes each to complete one consultation case. This assumption should be reviewed with SESA's consultants. Afterwards a new calculation should be made. The Action Plan should also be revised and adopt the end-2-end approach.

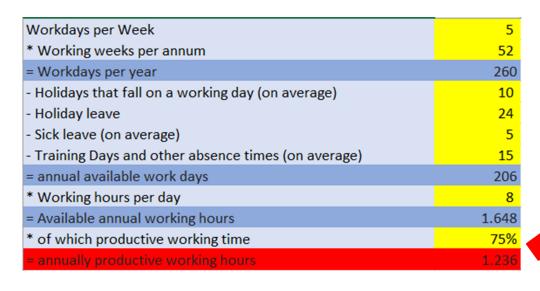


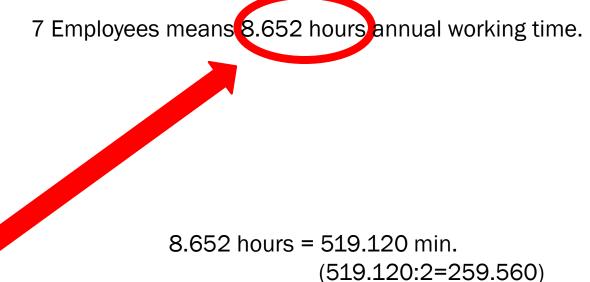
4. THE NEW SERVICE MODEL FOR JOBSEEKERS (E2E)

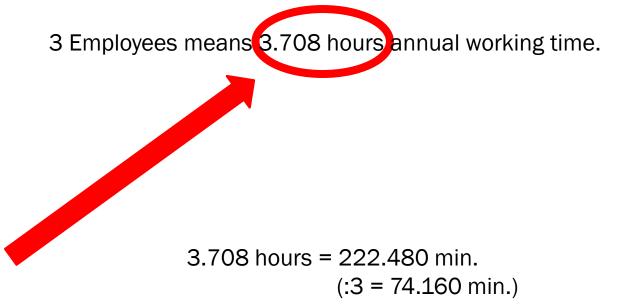

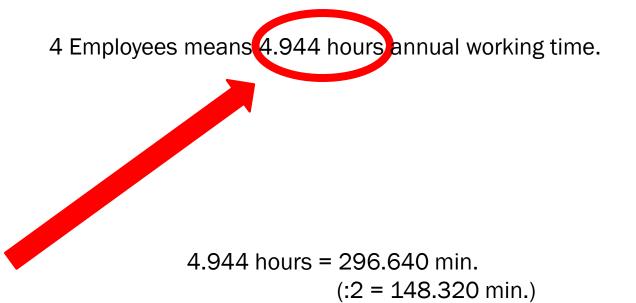

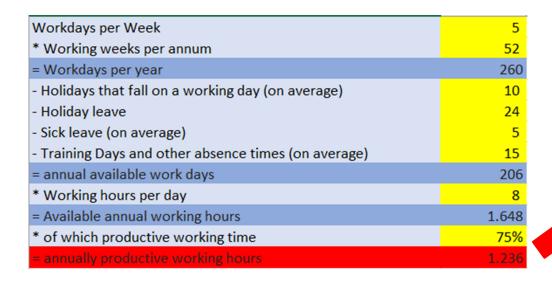

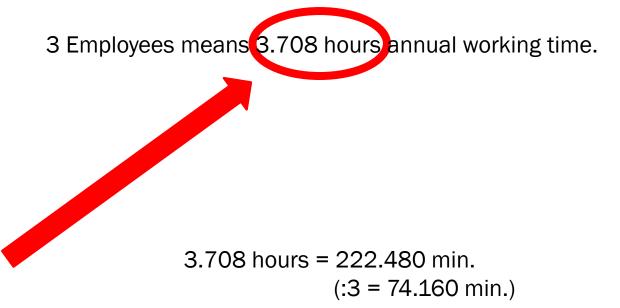

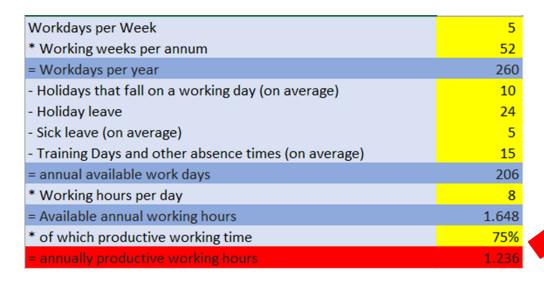

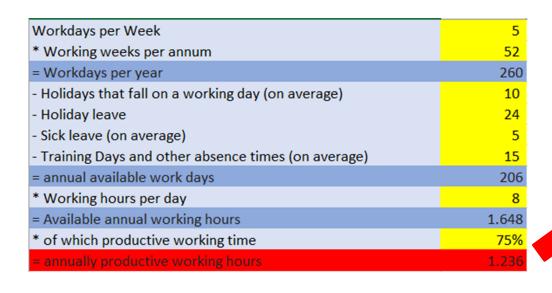
8. AVAILABLE WORKING HOURS IN MTSKHETA-MTIANETI WITH 1 EMPLOYEE

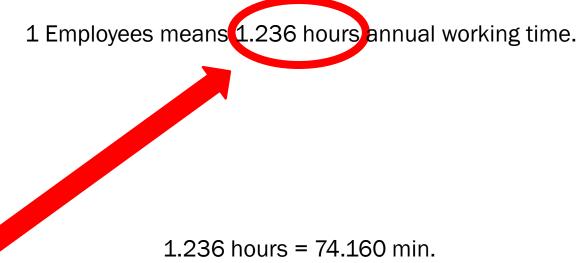

2. DISTRIBUTION OF AVAILABLE WORKING HOURS

The available annual working time can now be distributed to the end-2-end core processes of the New Service Model. With a 50:50 distribution between the services for jobseekers and employers, the services can be offered as frequently as shown in the table below.*

New Service Model Jobseeker - time need for one Case – 100 min.	1.001.160 min.: 100 = 10.011 Services annually
New Service Model Employer - time need for one Case – 100 min.	1.001.160 min.: 100 = 10.011 Services annually

Recommendation:

The 2021 Action Plan should be adapted with regard to the activities included in the end-2-end processes. All existing cases as well as new cases must be handled according to the new service model.
